*Prepare your home and property for wildfire!*

The Fire Safe Council of San Diego County is now offering *FREE* home ignition zone and defensible space assessments!

## What is a home assessment?

- 30-45 minute review of the vulnerability of your house and landscape to wildfire and ember ignition.
- Trained staff provide education, evaluation, and recommendations to help you meet your wildfire resilience goals.
- FREE of charge as grant funding permits.
- Registration is required through our website [www.firesafesdcounty.org/hap](http://www.firesafesdcounty.org/hap).

- Review of defensible space zones (Zone 0, 1, and 2).
- Landscaping suggestions that complement the defensible space zones.
- Review home hardening and ignition reduction measures.
- Recommendations for your specific property.
- Resources and program referrals to help you meet your wildfire resilience goals.
